Appointments at Omnes: Omnes welcomes a Compliance, Internal Control and Risk Management Analyst, a Principal, a Director, a Human Resources Manager; and also promotes a Principal and three Associates.

Mid Cap Buyout and Growth Capital

Yoann Malys joins the Mid Cap Buyout and Growth Capital team as Director, reporting to Eric Rey, Managing Partner.

The Mid Cap team invests in SMEs with strong growth potential via Omnes Croissance 4. This 4th generation fund (210 million euros) is invested in Cogepart (rapid shipping and delivery service), Dispam (controlled temperature shipping), Circet (telecommunications infrastructures) and ANI (distribution of fasteners for the aeronautics sector). In February 2017, it sold the Capcom company (installation of fibre optics and cable networks).
